## READ: Matthew 16.13-28; 1 Timothy 3.14-15; 1 Peter 4.8

#### 1. When was the church established?

- A. Some say in the days of Adam, Abraham, Moses, or John the Baptist. *Isaiah 2.2-4*; *Matthew 3.1-2*; *4.17*; *10.7*; *Luke 10.9*.
- B. Some say in the three years that Jesus walked upon the earth. Luke 24.44-49; Mark 9.1; Matthew 16.28.
- C. The Bible shows that the promise of Jesus to build the church was fulfilled on the day of Pentecost. *Matthew 16.13-19*; Acts 1 & 2.

#### 2. To whom does the church belong?

Acts 20.28; 1 Corinthians 12.28; 15.24; 1 Timothy 4.16; 1 Peter 1.19; 5.2; Hebrews 9.14.

- 3. What are the specifications of the church? John 10.16; Ephesians 4.4-6; 1.22-23; Colossians 1.9-20
- 4. Does the church that Jesus built exist today?
- A. YES! Matthew 16.18.
- B. What was the rock upon which the church was built? *Matthew 16.16; Acts 8.37; 1 Corinthians 3.11; Ephesians 2.20.*
- C. What was the foundation that was laid by Paul? 1 Corinthians 3.10; 15.1-4.
- D. Who is the source of all authority? *Matthew* 28.18-20; *John* 20.22-23; *Colossians* 1.18.

- E. How many heads and bodies does the church have? *Ephesians 1.22-23*; *Colossians 1.18*.
- F. What of the churches started by men? *Acts* 5.33-39; 1 Cor. 1.11-12; 3.1-7; Gal. 1.6-13.

- D. What did Saul of Tarsus do? Acts 9.16; 22.14-16; Believed: 9.5; 26.15; Repented: 9.8-11; 26.19; Baptized: 9.18: 22.16.
- E. What did Cornelius and his household do? *Acts* 10.34-38.
- F. What did Lydia and her household do? *Acts* 16.14-15.
- G. What did the jailor do? Acts 16.31-33.
- H. What did the Corinthians do? Acts 18.8.

#### 8. How is the church to worship?

- A. In what must we continue? Acts 2.42.

#### 9. How is the church to be organized?

- A. The word *church* is used four ways in the New Testament:
  - 1. The saved from the beginning to the end of the Christian age. *Col. 1.18*; *Hebrews 1.1*.
  - 2. The saved on one area. 2 Thessalonians 1.1; Acts 9.31, Galatians 1.2.
  - 3. Local congregations. Romans 16.16; 1 Corinthians 1.2.
  - 4. Independent bodies of Christ. 2 Corinthians 8.4.
- B. There were two classes of inspired men:
  - 1. Apostles. Acts 10.41; 13.31; 2 Peter 1.16; John 20.22-23.
  - 2. Prophet; inspired teacher. *Acts* 11.27; 13.1-2; *Ephesians* 4.11.
  - 3. Apostles and prophets ceased. 1 Corinthians 13.8.
- C. There are three classes of officers today:
  - 1. Elders, bishops, pastors, overseers, presbyters. All one office. *Titus 8.5-9; 1 Timothy 3.1-7; Acts 3.28; 1 Peter 5.3-4*.
  - 2. Deacons. Acts 6.1-6; 1 Timothy 3.8-13.
  - 3. Evangelist. Acts 21.8; Ephesians 4.11; 2 Timothy 4.5.

#### 10. What is the fruit of the church?

- A. Should Christians grow? *Matthew 28.19-20*; *Hebrews 5.12*; *1 Peter 2.2*; *2 Peter 1.5-8*; *3.18*.
- B. Is Christian liberality a fruit? Acts 2.42; 11.29-30; Philippians 1.3-5; 4.13-17.
- C. How do we glorify the Father? John 15.8.
- D. What should be the most burning desire of the members of the church? *Acts 8.4*; 11.19-21; 19.10; 20.20-21; Phil. 4.9; 2 Timothy 2.2.
